

Alps Cup 2023 – Kufstein

On the 25.06.2023 we will be holding the Alps Cup Championship 2023, in the Field Target Center Inntal in Kufstein. We would like to invite you to this event. The competition will be carried out under the regulations the WFTF and the ÖschO. The maximum number of participants is 50.

In addition to classes 1 - PCP 16 joules and 2 Springer 16 joules, this time also classes 3 - 4 - 5 will be held in 7.5 joules. For classes 1 - 2 the maximum distance is 50 meter, for classes 3,4,5 this is 35 meter.

Class overview:

1 - PCP 16,3 joules

2 - Springer 16,3 joules

3 - PCP 7,5 joules

4 - Springer 7,5 joules

5 - Semi-Recoilless (SRS) 7,5 joules

Important Information: Please bring robust shoes / boots with you, because you be in Alpine terrain, and we want you to be able to enjoy the beauty of the Kienbergklamm, without any problems.

Details:

It will be possible to use the zeroing range, although there may be a time limit, depending on the number of competitors. Only one start is possible per discipline.

For guests refreshments before, during, and after the event has been arranged. Mineralwater is available free of charge for all competitors. Other drinks and catering is available at the ÖM Arena.

Awards:

Medals and Certificates for the places 1 - 3

Shooting time:

Pro target 1 minute + 1 minute preparation. The shooting time starts when you take up the shooting position. Order of targeting: from left to right.

The muzzle energy of the weapons may not be higher than 16.3 Joules. Inspections will be made during the competition.

Muzzle energy Class 1 and 2 - not be higher than 16.3 Joules.

Muzzle energy Class 3,4,5 - not be higher than 7.5 Joules.

The hit quote will be recorded on the scoring cards handed out at the beginning of the competition by the competition director. These will be certified by him and his assistant.

Safety regulations:

The competition will be carried out under the regulations the WFTF and the ÖschO.

The orders of the Range officer are to be followed at all times.

In the case of a serious breach of the safety regulations the competitors will be disqualified.

All competitors must be registered at least 60 minutes before the start of the competition.

If a competitor does not start at his designated start time, he has no claim to a new start position.

The entry fee is "a repentance fee". That means that if the competitor does not show up the fee will not be refunded.
